The position of Organist/Pianist is a 30% position at First Congregational UCC in Madison, WI.

Compensation: \$15,000 annually

Our Sanctuary houses a well-maintained Holtkamp (Opus 1963, 1980). Manuals: 3. Stops: 37. Ranks: 38. Action: Slider chests. Mechanical key action. Electric stop action, and a 9 ft concert grand piano built by the Steinway Piano Company during the 1920s.

Job Description

1. Provide organ/piano music for Sunday worship service (10:00 a.m.), Christmas Eve (5:00 and 9:00 p.m.), Easter week services (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Sunday 7:30 and 10:00 a.m.), and special services as planned by the Staff Worship Team. This includes prelude, postlude solos, offertory solo or accompaniment, accompaniment for hymns, introit responses, and any other special music, providing all pertinent information of chosen music to the Director of Music Ministries in a timely fashion.
2. Accompany choir rehearsals and performances as requested by the Director of Music Ministries.
3. The church will pay for a substitute for three Sundays per year, according to vacation or schedule conflicts. Organist/Pianist is responsible for making arrangements for the substitute. Additional Sundays must be approved by the Director of Music Ministries and paid by the organist/pianist.
4. Organist/Pianist will have first opportunity to provide services for weddings (\$250) and memorial services (\$150) at First Congregational UCC. Clergy will work with the organist/pianist and family. These services will be paid by the family.
5. Organist/Pianist will work in close collaboration with the Staff Worship Team.

6. Organist/Pianist will provide keyboard support, if necessary for the youth/children's music program.
7. Organist/Pianist is encouraged to attend music conferences. Approved membership in music organizations and registration for one conference per year will be paid by the Church.
8. Organist/Pianist will work closely with the Director of Music Ministries to ensure instruments are cared for in a timely manner.
